²And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

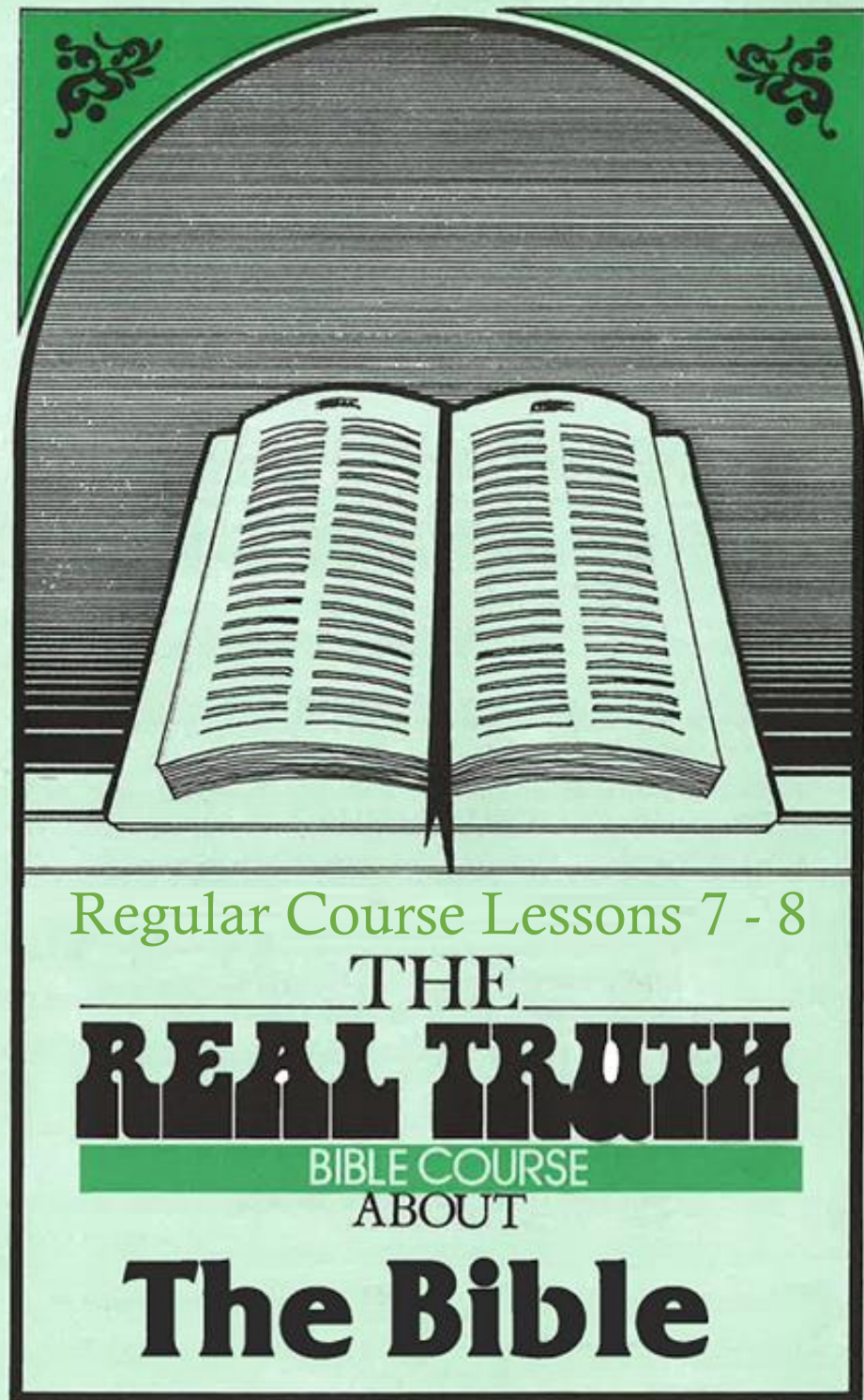

Introduction: Marriage is ordained of God to be a wonderful union of two lives, two loves, and two interests. Jesus gave the following commission to His disciples just before leaving them for His home in heaven: “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost; teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.” (Matthew 28:19-20)
